Subject:

Transfer from the General Fund to the Fire Equipment Fund

Introduction/Discussion:

The General Fund – Fund Balance has an estimated balance of \$5,180,555 pre-audit. The fund balance ratio to the 2025 is 67% at this time, which is well within State statue of 35%. The fund balance increased \$540,132. from 2024.

The Fire Equipment Fund started 2024 with a Cash Balance of \$558,633. Throughout the year there was an increase to cash in the amount of \$290,958 due to a transfer from the General Fund and investment income and a decrease of \$999,432 for the completion of Fire Station #3 and the purchase of Fire Engine #3. These activities caused the cash to be decreased by \$708,474 projected to end 2024 with a negative fund balance \$149,841.

In 2025, there is a budgeted \$285,000 transfer from the General Fund to replenish funds and an anticipated expenditure of \$970,000 to replace Fire Engine #2. This will cause the cash fund to be depleted another \$685,000 and ending 2025 with a projected 2025 Cash Balance of negative \$834,842.

For year end 2024, I am suggesting doing a one-time transfer from the General Fund of \$840,000 to replenish fund for 2024 and the project funds for 2025.

The transfer will decrease the General Fund Balance to an estimated \$4,340,555 and drop the Fund Balance Ratio to 56.51 percent.

Recommendation:

I recommend transferring \$840,000 from the General Fund to the Fire Equipment Fund.

Introduction/Discussion:

As a part of the 2025 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP), we planned on purchasing a new front-end loader from the Public Works Equipment Fund with an anticipated cost of \$322,900 for a new front-end loader. Quotes were obtained under State Contract Pricing from Nuss Trucking and Equipment in the amount of \$266,798 for a 2025 Volvo 70H Wheel Loader and from Lano Equipment, Inc. in the amount of \$50,621 for a Metalpless Pusher Snowplow with 6-foot wings attachment for the loader for snow removal. The total vehicle would come in at \$317,419 and would come from the Public Works Fund.

I then met with the Public Works Liaison's Councilmember Van Kirk and Doyle to discuss the purchase and quote. There was consensus by the liaisons to continue with the purchase process and to bring to Council for final approval.

Recommendation:

I recommend purchasing a 2025 Volvo 70H Wheel Loader from Nuss Equipment to be funded by the Public Works Equipment Fund for \$317,419.

2025 Recycling Dates

Introduction:

In 2025, the City will host two citywide recycling days on Saturday, May 3rd and September 6th from 8:00 a.m. until noon. The items that will be accepted at the citywide event are electronics, appliances, propane tanks, mattresses and box springs and tires. Public Works will take in scrap metal, car batteries, bicycles and brush.

Other recycling events for residents will be held at Recycle Technologies, Inc., formerly Green Lights Recycling, in Blaine on the following dates:

March 1st July 26th December 6th

All vendors' fees are paid for by the Anoka County Board of Commissioners and State SCORE (Select Committee on Recycling and the Environment) funds.

Attached is a list of vendors participating in our 2025 spring and fall recycling events. All vendors' fees are paid for by the Anoka County Board of Commissioners and State SCORE (Select Committee on Recycling and the Environment) funds.

A reuse/recycling event will be held again this year. The event last year was very successful. Anoka County wants to promote reuse throughout the county. One way to do this is to work with municipalities that have recycling days and city-wide garage sales (hosted by the Ham Lake Chamber of Commerce May 1-3) to keep reusable items out of the trash. Subject: 2025 Bituminous Overlay Project

Introduction:

Bids were opened yesterday for the scheduled bituminous overlay project. The project consists of the overlay of the residential subdivisions of Braastad Farms, Ravenwood Estates, Woodland Bluffs, Woodland Bluffs 2nd Addition, Pinger's Plaza Addition including 7th Street from 168th Avenue to 169th Avenue, 170th Avenue from the west plat border to the east plat border, Pingers Plaza Metes and Bounds including 7th Street from 169th Avenue to 170th Avenue excluding 3rd Street and MSA McKay Drive from 606 feet east of Jackson Street to 100 feet west of Taylor Street.

Discussion:

Eight bids were received and are shown in the attached breakdown. The base bid ranged between \$749,080.26 and \$809,957.53 with an average of \$774,522.57. Each bid included an alternate bid to include placing a portion of the millings obtained in preparation of the overlay project along Island Drive. The alternate bids ranged between \$752,725.14 and \$817,184.53, with an average bid of \$784,526.82. The difference between the base bid and alternate bid of the lowest bidder was \$3,644.88. The low bidder for either the base bid or alternate bid was North Valley, Inc.

Recommendation:

It is recommended to adopt the attached Resolution awarding the contract to North Valley, Inc. using the alternate bid in the amount of \$752,725.14 for the bituminous overlay project including the millings for Island Drive and Public Works.

Construction of the Highway 65 East Frontage Road from 171st Avenue to 334 feet

south of Crosstown Boulevard

Introduction:

The construction of the Highway 65 East Frontage Road will commence this summer depending on Federal Funding. Construction will be to a non-traditional MSA street section of 24 feet of bituminous with 5-foot bituminous shoulders. The street section does not include bike lanes.

Discussion:

The Highway 65 East Frontage Road is designated as a municipal state ais road. MnDOT requires a resolution restricting parking for municipal and county state aid projects when the proposed street width is not adequate for parallel parking on both sides of the street. Highway 65 East Frontage Road will not be updated such that there will insufficient pavement be parallel parking.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the attached Resolution be adopted that restricts parking on the Highway 65 East Frontage Road from 171st Avenue to Anoka County State Aid Highway 18 (Crosstown Boulevard).

WHEREAS, said proposed improvement does not conform to the approved minimum standards as previously adopted for such Municipal State Aid Streets and that approval of the proposed construction as a Municipal State Aid Street project must therefore be conditioned upon certain parking restrictions, and

WHEREAS, the extent of these restrictions that would be a necessary prerequisite to the approval of this construction as a Municipal State Aid project in the "City" has been determined.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAM LAKE, MINNESOTA:

RE: RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR MODERNIZING PEG FUNDING

Enclosed, please find for the council's review and approval a resolution supporting the Minnesota Association of Community Telecommunications Administrators (MACTA) efforts to modernize public, education, and government (PEG) programming/public access funding.

North Metro TV and other PEG TV stations face a challenging future as traditional revenue streams decline. MACTA, along with the League of Minnesota Cities, the League of Women Voters, and other organizations, are pursuing multiple avenues to modernize that funding at the state legislature. Municipal support for these efforts is extremely important and influential.

Possible solutions include:

- The Equal Access to Broadband Bill: This is the bill that MACTA pursued at the state legislature last year. It would allow cities to franchise wireline broadband providers and to impose a franchise fee on providers for using the public rights-of-way. The franchise would allow for oversight over broadband companies and require build out for an entire franchise area. The requirements would be similar to those in current cable franchises.
- A General Fund Request: MACTA is working to draft a bill requesting an amount equal to one dollar for every state resident from the State General Fund. Since not every city in the state is covered by a PEG station, MACTA currently estimates that the PEG stations that do exist would receive somewhere between one and two dollars per resident for a proposed two years of funding.

Recommendation:

That the City pass the resolution as recommended by the Telecommunications Commission Operations Committee.

I want to thank the Commission directors, staff, and the Operations Committee for their efforts in pursuing more modern and fair funding for North Metro TV and other PEG stations. ORDINANCE NO. 25-XX

FRANCHISE EXTENSION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, effective upon passage and acceptance, between the City of Ham Lake, Minnesota (the "City"), and Comcast of Minnesota, Inc., a Minnesota corporation ("Comcast").

WHEREAS, the City granted Comcast a non-exclusive franchise to construct, operate and maintain a cable television system through a cable television franchise ordinance accepted and agreed upon by Comcast (the "Franchise");

WHEREAS, the City, is a member of the North Metro Telecommunications Commission (the "Commission");

WHEREAS, Comcast and the Commission are parties to (1) a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) dated January 29, 1996; (2) the 1997 Resolution Transferring Community Television Programming Responsibilities from Group W of the North Central Suburbs, d/b/a Meredith Cable to the North Central; and (3) the Franchise Settlement Agreement dated December 17, 2014 (collectively the "Agreements");

WHEREAS, the term of the Franchise expired on or about December 31, 2020, and Comcast continued to operate under the terms and conditions of the Franchise; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the current Franchise and Agreements.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HAM LAKE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 2.4 of the Franchise is hereby amended by extending the term of such Franchise through and including June 30, 2030. The Parties do not waive any rights under Section 626 of the Federal Cable Act and agree that Grantee shall not be required to file an additional Section 626 Letter to preserve its rights to formal proceedings under the Franchise.

<u>Section 2</u>. Except as specifically modified hereby, the Franchise shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 3</u>. Neither party waives any rights under law as a result of agreeing to this Franchise extension.

<u>Section 4</u>. The Agreements shall remain effective so long as Comcast, including any successors or assigns, continues to operate under the Franchise, including as it may be extended pending the completion of the renewal process. Neither the Commission nor Comcast may terminate the Agreements prior to renewal.
